

**ATHENS AMVETS POST #76**  
**JAMES R. HARTLEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

In tribute to James Hartley, who died in his first term as our commanding officer, Athens AMVETS Post 76 will be awarding a \$2,000.00 scholarship to an Athens County High School senior who has been accepted into a degree program at Hocking College. The scholarship recipient will be selected based on the following criteria:

1. Academic achievement
2. Candidate must be the **son, daughter, step-son, step-daughter, or grandchild of a Veteran.**
3. Candidate's academic qualifications must be certified by an authorized representative (preferably principal or guidance counselor) of the candidate's high school; that representative must also sign the application form.
4. Candidate must submit a one page, preferably typed essay regarding his/her ambitions and goals.
5. Acceptance into an existing two year degree program at Hocking College.

The scholarship funds will be sent directly to Hocking College.

*The scholarship recipient must maintain full time status and meet satisfactory academic guidelines of the college.*

*The scholarship award will be divided equally over the academic term.*

*The scholarship awarded shall be used for educational expenses, including tuition, fees, books, supplies, room, board, and transportation.*

Judging will be done by a 5 member committee who score the criteria individually.

If the scholarship recipient is successful in completing the first year of the two year program, he or she becomes eligible for the scholarship for the second year if they are in good standing with Hocking College.
